### JAKE'S PLACE

Nicole has been working with the Washington Township Council to bring a brand new, all inclusive adaptive playground to Washington Lake Park! They recently applied for the Green Acres Grant and are awaiting the news on a chosen recipient. If chosen, the Grant will match 75% up to \$750,000 of what is raised! Under Jake's Law, funding from the Green Acres Grant must be used to build an inclusion playground. The Build Jakes Place Foundation is in support of Nicole and the Washington Township Project and all are looking forward to a community build hopefully one day soon! This will be the first and only Jake's Place in Gloucester County!

If Washington Township is not chosen for this year's grant, Nicole is committed to continue raising money until the playground is built. Every child deserves to play

An all-inclusive playground is an integrated play area in which all children, those who are able and those with disabilities, can play interactively. The objective is to design an area that is barrier-free, socially inviting, and contains play environment groupings.

### **BIRDS BACKPACK PROJECT**

The BIRDS (Basic Immediate Response Developmental & Sensory) Backpack is an absolute MUST for First Responders! The light-weight backpack is able to be carried by a child/adult that is unable to carry things in their hands. It is filled with important items that can help first responders with those that have special needs during an emergency - especially if a parent or guardian is unavailable to be with them for a period of time or they are injured themselves.

Some of the items in the bag - noise cancelling headphones, dark sunglasses, sensory and fidget toys, a notepad with crayons, a weighted lap mat, a sensory chew necklace and a communication card with appropriate words, images and phrases for any type of emergency situation.

Our goal is to equip local emergency response vehicles with the backpack and provide training on use. We also look to provide training to emergency response departments on handling emergency situations with individuals with special needs as a whole.
